Distance: Approximately 8.25 miles, much of which is on the scenic D&H Canal towpath

Cost: \$18.00 if received by Sept 1st, \$20.00 until Sept 30th, \$22.00 after Sept 30th
Under 21 - \$14.00/\$16.00/\$18.00 in conjunction with the above schedule.

What you get: A scenic run, a commemorative wine glass, and a pair of warm gloves

Parking: Parking at the BashaKill Vineyards will be **extremely limited**. Carpooling with 3-4 people per car is essential. Alternatively, several people can drive in separate cars to the Emma Chase School on Pennsylvania Ave in the village of Wurtsboro (about 5 miles from the vineyards) and then carpool in one car from there.

What is 750 Events ?

750 Events is an event production and management company that brings the running/walking community together with the local wine industry. Our goal is to showcase the products of the region's best vintners while at the same time promoting a healthy, physically-active lifestyle.

What are the Vintage Runs?

The Vintage Runs are a series of low-key running events that are designed with fun and recreation in mind rather than hard-nosed competition. Each run will take place either at or within stone's-throw distance of a popular local vineyard. Most runs feature scenic country views that may include vineyards, mountain views, orchards, or in some cases, all three. After the run is over, you'll be invited to partake in the quality offerings of the host winery.

How long are the runs ?

A typical Vintage Run will be between 2.5 and 4 miles (with a few that are longer), allowing people of most all ages and abilities to successfully complete the distance by either running or walking. The low-key nature of our events makes them attractive as a group outing, wherein you can celebrate your physical achievement together over a glass of your favorite variety of wine.

How do the Vintage Runs work?

A Vintage Run is not a race. You'll be given a finishing time, but there are no finisher's medals or age group awards. The emphasis of these events is on recreation and fun. All persons age 21 and above will receive a commemorative wine glass from the winery, and each participant – regardless of age – will receive a small keepsake (each run may have something different). With so many wineries in the Hudson Valley, our year-long series of events will give you opportunity to combine your love of healthy outdoor activity with a broad spectrum of great wines!
